

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The SANT BANI ASHRAM in Italy, Tuscany was founded in 1979 by Master Sirio. [A part of the farm's territory is the private property of the Master and another part along with the buildings on it he donated to the nonprofit Sant Bani Ashram association for its activity.] Since its foundation, many spiritual retreats have been organized and are being organized here every year.

THE ATMOSPHERE IS VERY SPECIAL, VERY PEACEFUL, VERY RELAXING AND VERY SILENT. WE COULD SAY VERY HOLY.

A functioning Sant Mat or Surat Shabd Yoga Meditation Centre in Europe which offers regular spiritual (intense meditation) retreats for all sincere seeking souls who would like to benefit from the teachings of Master Sirio and this special place, experiencing its atmosphere.

It was also the location of three big European spiritual programs of Master Sant Ajaib Singh: in 1980, 1984 and 1989 with the participation of several hundred people.





A D M I N I S T R A T I O N

The Ashram is run by the **nonprofit Sant Bani Ashram Association**.

Anyone who is attending the programs must be registered as a member of the Association. All the possibilities are only and exclusively offered to the registered members. (A symbolic inscription fee is to be paid for administrative reasons which is 5 euros/year.)

There's an **Administrative Council** of the Association, that consists of the **President**, the **Vice-President** and the **Secretary**.

The president of the Ashram is *Master Sirio Ji* (middle) who doesn't take anything for his spiritual work. He maintains and takes care of the Ashram in a completely nonprofit way, free of charge as a selfless service.

The vice-president is *Dorottya Fary* (right) (economist and public administration manager), and the secretary is *Loretta Sapora* (*left*) (doctor in psychology).



Since the scope of the Sant Bani Ashram Association is the spreading of Surat Shabd Yoga, it also functions as a small **publisher (SBA Books) for spiritual literature**. The Association also has a small spiritual **library** (Italian and English language literature) that tries to offer a view on spirituality, especially from the view of Surat Shabd Yoga and its Masters.

EQUIPMENT

Since its foundation in 1979 lots of work has been done in the Ashram so by now from the beginning spartan simplicity, through the dedicated and selfless work of Master Sirio, it has become a well-equipped place, besides remaining an isolated and very peaceful sanctuary in nature, far from everything. There is water, electricity, solar panels, an artificial lake for irrigation, heating, internet (wi-fi) connection. Most of the furniture in the Ashram is handmade of wood by Master Sirio.

There are **four buildings** that include a separate gents' and ladies' dormitory with kitchen and dining hall, **meditation and Satsang room**, where yoga is also practised. Above this, there's a large **yurt** under a huge oak tree, that also can be used - by opening its sides - as an outdoor meditation place, to sit in peace and enjoy meditation and Satsang or do yoga in nature.

A few years ago the Ashram was broadened with a **therapeutic section**, that is called Sirio Ayurveda, where it is possible to be renewed physically, to heal and purify with the help of Ayurvedic treatments. This way we may be renewed by the means of the more than a thousand years old, ancient but still living knowledge, and Master Sirio's decades' experience, who is an expert in Ayurveda. The director of this therapeutic centre is one of the disciples of Master Sirio who has learnt this ancient science personally from the Master through the years, practising by his side. The Sant Bani Ashram in Ribolla is really the place where Heaven and Earth meet, where body and soul may be reborn for the **complete human well-being** on all levels of our existence.









RULES

The Sant Bani Ashram Association only welcomes those seekers who are ready to respect the place and keep its rules.

The Ashram is a **non-smoking**, **vegetarian** place where it's not allowed to smoke and it's **forbidden to use any kind of drugs or to drink alcohol**. People while staying here are requested to follow a vegetarian diet (no meat, no fish, no eggs). Those who break these rules, and behave disrespectfully towards the place, the Master or any other person who is staying in the Ashram are requested to leave immediately.

There's no spiritual community in the Ashram.

Out of the programs people have to ask permission to stay here, but as a general rule, no one can stay longer than two weeks. People sometimes come to offer help, as a selfless service in the bigger maintenance works, or in the preparation for the programs, cleaning etc.





SPIRITUAL RETREATS

The Sant Bani Ashram offers a unique opportunity for those seeking profound spiritual growth through intense meditation retreats.

An intense spiritual meditation retreat is a **transformative experience**, offering a chance to step away from the busyness of daily life and dive deeply into spiritual practice. The practice involves deep meditation, self-introspection, experiencing higher states of consciousness, spiritual teachings, and benefiting from communal support of the fellow participants.

This complex approach helps participants to not only evolve in their spiritual life but also to apply the insights and peace gained during the program into their daily lives, leaving with a renewed sense of purpose, inner peace, and a deeper connection to their spiritual self and path. Whether you are an experienced meditator or new to the practice, **these** occasions provide invaluable experiences for your spiritual journey and the transformation of your life.



To offer this possibility for the benefit of all interested, regular intensive spiritual meditation retreats and meetings are organised, several times a year in the serene environment of the Ashram which provides the perfect setting for deep introspection and spiritual renewal.

The main programs are the **Spring**, **Summer** and **Autumn retreats** which usually last a week. Above these there are monthly regular meetings at which anyone can participate.



INTRODUCTON OF THE SANT BANI ASHRAM SPIRITUAL RETREATS CONTINUED

Retreats give the chance and opportunity to attendees to immerse themselves in meditation, participate in Satsangs (spiritual discourses on the philosophy of the Masters), and experience the transformative power of Surat Shabd Yoga under the guidance of an authentic realised master, **Satguru Sirio Ji**.

During retreats an **intensive inner spiritual work** happens that might provoke deep changes, therefore the program is structured in such a way **to maximize spiritual practice** and **minimize distractions**. The schedule includes early morning meditation session, followed by hatha yoga and pranayama to prepare the body and mind for deeper meditation. Throughout the day, there are periods of silence, allowing participants to reflect and internalize their experiences. The highlight of the day is the Satsang when attendees can listen to the teachings of the Master who has a peculiar ability to give very clear explanations on very complex topics. Satsang is not only a philosophical discourse, but a great source of inspiration, encouragement and reinforcement to proceed on the path. The day closes with an uplifting hour of nada yoga concert given by Master Sirio Ji. During the day there is lots of mantra and bhajan singing in group which is an uplifting and relaxing experience, transporting the mind into a meditative state of consciousness which is favourable for meditation.

Another aspect of these programs is that engaging with fellow retreat participants builds up a sense of community and shared purpose, which can be uplifting and motivating. But of course this sharing shouldn't be exaggerated to not be distracted from the main focus and should be limited to spiritual topics.

The meditation sessions in the company of the Master allow practitioners to transcend ordinary consciousness and experience states of pure awareness and bliss. Such intensive practice can lead to moments of spiritual awakening, where participants gain profound insights into Reality and their place within it.



INTRODUCTON OF THE SANT BANI ASHRAM SPIRITUAL RETREATS CONTINUED ACCOMMODATION AND MEALS

Participants can stay here for the complete time of the retreat. The Ashram provides comfortable accommodations, in the separate male and female dormitories. designed to support a simple and focused lifestyle. You are given a bed, bed linen and three times meals.

All meals are strictly vegetarian, in line with the Ashram's principles - the diet excludes meat, fish, and eggs - and prepared with love, care and attention to nourish both body and soul, designed to support meditation. The menu includes a variety of fresh vegetables, fruits, grains, and legumes, ensuring that meals are nutritious and balanced. Participants must indicate in advance if anyone has any special needs, allergies etc. We're against food waste, so participants are requested to respect this during their stay.



<u>COST</u>

For your stay (bed+3 vegetarian meals) you're invited to <u>donate at least 30</u> <u>euros/day/person that just covers the costs of staying (water, electricity, bed linen, food).</u>

Above this one can offer donations to the nonprofit Sant Bani Ashram Association for the maintenance and improvement of the place that selflessly gives home in its wonderful environment for spiritual seekers for their time of participating in retreats.

The Master's teachings are given for free!

I fully agree with Him after all these many years of immense work, facing incredible and apparently, insurmountable challenges.



Well, about this place I can definitely say that what it is now is immensely better than what it was in the beginning. I hope, if it is in His will, that this place will keep shining even when I won't be in this world any more.

I bought this place in the very beginning thanks to some inheritance that I received from my father, and also thanks to the resources that I gathered, by and by, through my work. My Satguru Ajaib encouraged me to put myself in this adventure because He said, "It will be a good service rendered to your soul". Right, He was, it has actually been the best thing I could have done in my life for my evolution. Nothing could have allowed me to have all the wonderful experiences I have had in the process of developing this Ashram.

Sant Ji came here on three occasions: in 1980, at the very beginning of this adventure. In 1984, when a boost was very needed to continue in this endeavour, the strength to face the unrelenting challenges that one has to face whenever one wants to offer his/her life, in the service of supreme Truth.



Then he returned here in 1989, and that was the occasion when this place really became a functioning Ashram. Up to that point, we (me, my wife Irena, and our daughter Nirmala) had lived here in a very rudimental lifestyle: no electricity, therefore, no fridge, no washing machine, no television, obviously no internet, no telephone etc, and we were very happy with that sort of lifestyle. Nonetheless, when you want to organise a programme with some hundred people, that is not the most helpful effective situation. Sant and Ji never complained about the lack of these factors, on the other hand, He himself was living a very simple life in His Thar desert Ashram where all these conveniences were also absent. He was very happy with the way things were happening and the two first programmes were blessed with incredible super divine interventions and manifestations of His power. In 1989 we really did our best to make this Ashram more functional so has to have a better organized programme.

People came from all over to help: from North America, South America and Europe, we got electricity and we made all the systems to well equip the Ashram with everything needed to face the situation: water system, electricity system, running water, meditation and Satsang place, langar place, kitchen place, a house for Sant Ji, and so forth. Everything went in the most wonderful way, the programme was very successful, Sant Ji was very happy and I was very thankful to my Satgurus for the extraordinary result.

Eventually, Sant Ji left the body in 1997, He had been the engine of this project, but now that he wasn't there anymore it could have become very difficult to keep the Ashram going. Generally, when the Master leaves the body, the enthusiasm fades away and people tend to forget how it was. I was very blessed because Sant Ji and Master Kirpal both came to live here in my very body and made the continuation of this adventure possible.

At the end of the 1989 programme an American Satsangi wrote that this Ashram was the most beautiful place on earth. [You can read the article in this magazine as well.] Well, if he were to see this place now, he wouldn't recognize it because it has become ten times more beautiful. Satguru's blessings have been continuously pouring on this person and this place and all that was needed to make this Ashram what it is now was provided by His grace.

Moreover, the good health, strength and will needed by this person to keep it in the most dignified and well-kept way is provided all the time. I like doing this mostly myself for the well-functioning of this place, and when I need help from somebody, the help always comes.

The invisible Power of the Supreme has always, at any stage of this adventure, provided me with the right people to help me carry on this work. At this stage a very competent and good willing somebody was needed to keep this work going, therefore, my Satgurus, through their mysterious and unpredictable way, have allowed Dori Ji to come and live here so that she can contribute to the work needed to keep going in the best way possible according to the real need of this time. Podcast, maintaining the website, daily meditation podcast, public relations organising the work and inspiring some good willing people to cooperate, all done by her. Dustin, Laci, Tamar, Vali, Jozsi and Ricsi Ji have also revealed themself to be very helpful and good willing.

Nonetheless, a place like this and the literary work that Dori keeps doing on the web and all around requires money, the food and several items needed for a retreat cost money and prices keep rising, therefore, for this reason, we ask attendants of the retreats to contribute with at least thirty euros per day to cover the cost of their staying otherwise this work couldn't continue.

SANT JI'S VISIT to Italy was beautiful, and it seemed to me that this Tour in Italy went about as smoothly, and as successfully, as any Tour has ever gone. And this is due to a great deal of love and cooperation among the European Satsangis - and some Americans too, who went over and did seva for several weeks or months before the Master arrived.

THE ASHRAM IN ITALY IS ONE OF THE MOST BEAUTIFUL PLACES ON THIS EARTH. IT IS ABSOLUTELY EXQUISITE; IT'S LIKE A JEWEL. IT'S IN THE APPENINE HILLS, NOT VERY FAR FROM SAINT FRANCIS' COUNTRY, IN TUSCANY, WHAT WE MIGHT CALL THE "SPIRITUAL" PART OF ITALY; AND IT IS NOT FAR FROM THE COAST EITHER, ALTHOUGH YOU CAN'T SEE THE COAST FROM THE ASHRAM. WHAT YOU DO SEE IS A MAGNIFICENT, BEAUTIFUL SWEEP OF MOUNTAINS AND HILLSIDE; AND OF COURSE WHEN THE MASTER IS THERE YOU SEE ALL KINDS OF TENTS AND TRAVEL VEHICLES, ETC., DOTTED ON THE NEAR HILLSIDE, AND ALL KINDS OF PEOPLE WHO ARE THERE BECAUSE OF HIM.

The place is beautiful, and the way in which things were handled was extremely appropriate. And I think that the Master was able to accomplish what He went there for with a minimum of problem which is always the aim in preparing for a Tour: to make His work, work, as well as it can. And He gave a great deal. I think He gave a great deal to everyone. From my point of view I see it through a prism of infinite protectiveness and very tender care, with which I was surrounded. My brothers and sisters in Italy knew that I had been sick, and they treated me accordingly.

There were about three hundred people there from all over Europe, and what was provided for them was perfect. The langar was wonderful.

Initiation was given in five languages.

I found the Satsangs in Italy extremely interesting and thought-provoking. He told a number of stories. One struck me as a very important story, as important as any the Master has ever told. Sant Ji has told it before, and I think Master Kirpal also told it.

It's the story of Mana, the disciple of Guru Arjan Dev, who refused to do what his brother and sister Satsangis told him to do. He was supposedly a sevadar; he was at Guru Arjan's ashram; and he wouldn't do seva, because the people who were giving him orders were his equals. He told them, "I'm not going to obey you; I obey only the Master." So people complained about him, and he was taken to the Master. And the Master said, "Well, what is this?" and Mana said, "Well, I don't want to obey them, Master, because they are my equals. I only want to obey You. You give me an order and I will obey it." And Guru Arjan looked at him and said, "All right. Go into the forest, build a fire, and then jump into it and burn yourself to death." Mana said, "Yes, Master." He went into the forest and built a fire, but he didn't jump into it; he realized that he didn't really want to do that, and he started to ponder what to do next. In the meantime, a thief who had just stolen a lot of jewelry from a house, and who was being chased by the police, ran up to Mana and asked him what he was doing. Mana told him and the thief said, "All right, I will give you the jewelry" that I have taken, and you give me the Master's order; I will jump in and do what He said." So Mana said, "Well, that's a good deal," and he took the jewelry, and the thief jumped into the fire, burned himself to death, and was immediately met by the Master and taken up. In the meantime Mana was there with the jewelry and, predictably enough. the police arrived a few minutes later. Mana was the only one there, and he had the jewelry, so they arrested him. And although he protested and told them what had happened, they guite understandably didn't believe him. So he was hanged, which was the penalty for thievery in those days. Now this story is disturbing on the face of it, because of the idea of the Guru giving you horrible orders - the kind which the Guru never does. (I mean, who wants to be told to build a fire and jump into it?) But if we think about it, we can see the point of this story. For one thing, there is an obvious point here which is sometimes very difficult for us to grasp. That is, the difference between saying something and doing it. It was very easy for Mana to say, "I will obey the order of the Master." In fact, he couldn't do it. He couldn't come close to it. And for any of us there is this discrepancy. as in the story of the swan and the crane - the idea of imitating the Master. It is possible up to a certain point only. Beyond that point, we don't have the ability to do that. Mana declared that he would only obey the order of the Master; he would not obey the orders of his equals. And yet in fact he couldn't do either. And he didn't do either.

The other thing is of course the principal error, and obviously Sant Ji was making a point here about the satsangis cooperating with each other, and the way in which the Master works. That is to say, some satsangis are given authority for certain jobs, and others are given authority for other jobs, and so on down the line; and if we don't cooperate with each other, obviously, how is it going to happen? And in the Tour situation especially: we were in the middle of something which could not have happened had not people obeyed their equals.

There was a great deal of seva to be done, and it had to be organized and directed, and it was; it was organized very successfully. So it was kind of a living example of what is required. But if we won't do that, it's like refusing to understand the extent to which the Path permeates our life. I use the word "permeate" advisedly: it is intermingled, intertwined; there is no compartmentalization possible. What Mana didn't understand - and we often don't understand - is that the orders that his equals were giving him were, in fact, what the Master wanted him to have.

Now the idea of our circumstances being a gift from the Master can be misused, and no one has to remain in an ugly situation because they think it's the Master's wish; Master doesn't want that from any of us. But still, to a great extent we don't see the way in which our present situation, whatever it is, can be used for our own growth if we grasp that it has been given to us by the Master.

A winding unpaved road is leading to the top of the hill among olive fields and vineyards. White and golden wrought iron gates, on the pillars swan statues which are the symbols of the purified souls.

Arriving into the Ashram is always the fulfilment of a moment filled with expectations. It is almost 35 years now [at the time of the article] that this spiritual centre took shape from the wilderness by the all-sacrificing, superhuman work of Master Sirio. Pure because it is the same from inside as it is from outside. Deep because of being present in every moment, spiritual practice is the most important part of life. Sincere – that means in its complete simplicity to talk according to thoughts and act according to words. This way

This is the real, rare treasure. It is worth more than if gems were paying the road instead of stones. Of course, we may doubt if such a thing may exist. But everybody who would like to dissolve his or her scepticism may be certain about it personally.

This event took place before I was initiated and although our entire family had felt the Love, protection and spiritual presence of Master Kirpal, I was determined to live a normal life.

Not long after this however, I decided to experience what it was like to sit in front of a perfect Master as Sant Ji was having a retreat in Silly-Tillard France. I felt instinctively that this was my once in a lifetime opportunity to witness Sat Ajaib Singh Ji in person so I grasped the opportunity. What I experienced in His presence changed my life and I too came to realise that Sant Ji was a perfect Master and I was initiated there in Silly-Tillard France in 1993.

Moving forward I was introduced to Master Sirio in 2015 and was again made aware that He is a perfect Master. Master Sirio initiated my Mum, Dorothy Sharp and this was the final missing piece of our family. We were now all initiated by Masters Kirpal, Ajaib and Sirio.

What a privilege this is and following a retreat in Currer-Laithe farm, England, I was approached by Dori who had looked after us all on the retreat. She said, that she had a vision and had seen my Dad and I in the Ribolla Ashram. I was saddened by this as I realised that if Dad and I were there alone, my Mum would have passed. Also it is not something that I had ever considered to do, travel to Italy and go to the Ashram. Indeed my Mum passed the following year and after a while Dad asked if I would like to go to the Italy Ashram. I said I would go if he came with me, but Dad said I am too old now in my 90's, but you should go. I said I would consider it but asked my Dad to try to make himself able to go.

I really felt that I again wanted to experience the Ashram and sit in front of the physical presence of Perfect Master Sirio. I made the journey and what greeted me, was something completely unexpected. The white swans on the gates and the Sant Bani Ashram sign welcome all. But it was, to me, like entering a different environment to anywhere else I have ever been.

The Ashram is very beautiful and perfectly maintained, built with imaginative parts that you cannot hope to expect. The air is sweet and filled with birds chirping and grasshoppers making their music. There is a palpable thing, it seems, to me, that Time is not in residence here. Something is so different and I feel it pervade through me. The buildings are built with Master Sirio's own hands and so are blessed.

I attended a programme and soon realised that Master took every session from morning to night including wonderful evening concerts of spiritual Love songs to His Masters. SATGURU MY BELOVED, PLEASE IMPROVE MY LIFE

Satguru my Beloved, please improve my life, Suffering because of Karma, I am praying at Your door.

Over you I have no control, over You I have no power, Except Your in this world, no one belongs to me.

I have come to Your refuge, do not refuse me, I have has so many troubles, enough of agony.

Refresh my heart which is inflamed with pain, O Beloved Satguru, please improve my life.

What is a prayer in reality? Why do we pray? Is prayer effective? What actually happens when we pray? Should we pray at all? First of all for what do we pray? For what should we pray?

SEEK YOU FIRST THE KINGDOM OF GOD AND ALL THE REST SHALL BE GRANTED TO YOU.

Therefore, here we are told that, if we are capable to attract into our life the presence, the grace of God, then we shall have all we need to live a good dignified life without ever asking for it. Similar attracts similar, therefore if we are tuned in with His presence, than we are very well taken care of and all of our needs, physical and spiritual, will be provided.



Most of the time the Masters tells us not to pray for worldly things but only for the spiritual ones because God knows very well what our needs are, therefore, if we are tuned in spiritually all the needed things will automatically come our way.

In this song, Sant ji, begins by praying to His beloved Satguru to please improve his life, because suffering by karma, He has gone to His door.

So this should be our main request:

PLEASE, IMPROVE MY LIFE, HELP ME TO GET RID OF ALL THE BAD HABITS I HAVE BECAUSE THEY ARE THE REASON FOR ALL MY MISERY.



You see, we all suffer from lust, anger, greed, attachment, egoism, vanity, arrogance, jealousy, envy, hate and many others, and these are the main causes of all our sufferings. Therefore we should try to get rid of all of those and make ourselves as pure and goodhearted as the most holy people. How beautiful a life we would have if none of this bad traits were to be present in our person.

So our constant prayer should be about getting rid of all of this unwanted stuff that degrades our person, and become a brilliant example of a very honest, good, trustworthy, real and true person.

It is very important to set goals for our life on a yearly base, on a monthly base, on a weekly base and on a daily base. We should be very careful watching our thoughts words and deeds and be very careful that they are all motivated by compassion and goodness. Master Kirpal used to say that before we say anything we should check that is going to be good, appropriate, helpful and uplifting for the people involved; not harmful to anybody. Now, we know that most of the time we do not speak motivated by all these good reasons and we are very instinctive, just going by the emotion that suddenly surge within us. Well, that has to change if we want to be good and do good. Therefore, Oh good God,

> PLEASE IMPROVE OUR LIFE, THE OUALITY OF OUR PERSON, LET US BE PEOPLE THAT BRING PEACE AND JOY WHEREVER WE GO.



There is this simple prayer of Saint Francis of Assisi that tells us all we need to pray for:

God make me an instrument of your peace, where there is hate let me bring love, Where there is offence let me bring forgiveness, Where there is disagreement let me bring union, Where there is doubt let me bring faith, Where there is error let me bring the truth, Where there is desperation let me bring hope, Where there sadness let me bring joy, Where there is darkness let me bring the light. O Master let it be that I do not seek so much to be consoled as much to console, to be understood as much as to understand To be loved as much as to love. Because it is only by giving that we will receive, If we forgive we'll be forgiven Only by dyeing we'll be reborn to eternal life.



How much this world would be different if all the people of this planet were to behave this way. A heaven it would be, but then it wouldn't be physical any more. The consistency of this planet would change and that of our bodies too.

We must understand that it is not so much what we believe in that is so important, but the thoughts that we think, the words that we speak and the actions that we perform are what count.

> NOT THOSE WHO SAY LORD, LORD, WILL ENTER INTO THE REALM OF TRUTH, BUT THOSE WHO LIVE ACCORDING TO THE WILL OF GOD.



Living by His will it means to be constantly inspired by the Truth, the Light of the Divine not by the ordinary mind, not by the animal instincts, not by the many bad attributes about which I wrote in the beginning of this Satsang.

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I HAVE COME TO YOUR REFUGE, DO NOT REJECT ME, I HAVE HAD SO MANY SUFFERINGS, ENOUGH OF AGONY.



Sant Ji understood very well that by ourselves we would never succeed in overcoming, winning over all this weaknesses of ours, that we need to go into the refuge of a Satguru because there we will get help, the strength to fight and win over all these imperfections that torment our waking state and our dreams as well.

I have come to you, Oh Master, please accept me and let it be in my faith that no matter what, I will never leave you. Let it be that my ego, my arrogance, my wrong understanding of facts, my illusions and delusions, my stupidity may never take me away from your Sharan, your refuge. Oh Master,

> PLEASE COOL DOWN MY HEART WHICH IS INFLAMED WITH SUFFERINGS, LET ME FIND PEACE, LET ME BE TRANSFORMED, RENEWED, LET MY OLD SELF DIE AND A NEW MAN BE BORN, A MAN FREE FROM ALL THIS BAD ATTRIBUTES.





An other fantastic prayer by my Satguru Ajaib goes like this:


O writer of fortunes with mercy write on my heart love for the Master.

Do not write on thing, separation from the Guru It doesn't matter if you write separation from the all world.



Is there any worldly request in all this very beautiful prayers? None at all, only the grace to live the most humble, loving, helpful, sincere relation with our Master. In a nutshell, He asks His Master, let me love you, let my hands, my body and mind be used for your service, let my inner ears by saturated with the Sound current, let Your Name always be on my tongue, let your Light shine on my forehead, let my eyes see You always. Do not allow that I may be separated from You because that would be the greatest misfortune for me. If in order to achieve this I need to separate from all the world, from all my attachments, my belongings, my secure zone, my egocentric surreal world, well I am ready for it as far as you are always by my side, as far as you stand by me.

THEREFORE, WHAT IS PRAYER AND FOR WHAT SHOULD A TRUE SEEKER OF TRUTH PRAY?

For realising the Godhead by overcoming and winning over all the degrading attributes that deteriorate us human beings, and become saturated with love, compassion, goodwill, the determination to always do good, be good and achieve Oneness.

NOW, IS PRAYER REALLY EFFECTIVE, IS THERE ANY BODY TO LISTEN TO OUR REQUESTS AND HELP US OUT BY ANSWERING OUR REQUESTS?

There are people who say that they have been praying for so many years, but none of their prayers were ever answered. I know a person, a brother of mine, who has been a practising Christian for most of his life to eventually end up becoming an atheist because he says, God never answered any of my prayers and there is nobody there to answer the requests of anybody because there is no God whatsoever.

I also know people who are initiated by me that tell me that all their life is a miracle, that they see wonders happening at every step. At The time of Master Kirpal I knew many people who said this very thing, at the time of Sant Ji Maharaj many people used to say the same, and now as well.

So, how is it possible that a person says that no prayer was ever answered, and others say that none of their prayers as ever been answered. In my understanding it all depends on the intensity of our relation with God, on the grace of a living Master. This is the difference in between following a religion, believing in a Master of centuries or millennials ago and following a true living Master who is here to connect seekers with the divine power.

This is the reason why Maulana Rumi says that half an hour spent in the company of a living Master is more beneficial than fifty years of solitary prayers in our home.



THEREFORE, PRAY, MEDITATE, SING THE PRAISES OF GOD AND SATGURU, BUT ASSOCIATE WITH A LIVING MASTER IF YOU WANT ALL OF THESE YOUR EFFORTS TO BE EFFECTIVE.









PRAYER WHOM TO ADDRESS CONTINUED

A PRAYER TO THE LIVING MASTER IS AS GOOD AS A PRAYER TO GOD.

One must, therefore, wholly and solely depend on the Master and turn to Him for the fulfilment of his desires. So all prayers should be addressed to one who holds the mystery of life and death in his hands. We must have perfect faith in the living God, who lives and moves amongst us in a human form. With the attention fully focused on Him, we ought not to think of anyone else. This is the one way we can commune with Him. Kabir Sahib tells us that distance does not count in the relationship between the Master and the disciple. The two may be separated by vast oceans in between, but the very thought of the Master, in the disciple, is bound to attract the Master's attention and he can direct him (the disciple) wherever he may be. It is said of Vivekananda that when he rose to address the World Parliament of Religions in Chicago he felt diffident. He asked for a glass of water, closed his eyes for a moment, and thought of his Master (Paramhansa Ramakrishna, the sage of Dakshineswar) and in an instant the floodgates of inspiration opened within him, and he delivered an unprecedented and impassioned discourse lasting for several hours. A Godman is a veritable king, and at his door all the mighty kings of the earth bow down their heads in humble supplication and seek the fulfilment of their cherished desires and attainment of their otherwise unattainable ambitions.


Guru Arjan says in this context:

He has within his controlling power all the potentates, Nay, the vast creation itself is under his sway. His will reigns supreme everywhere, And nothing lies outside his Divine Will; O offer thy prayer to thy Master alone, For he shall fulfil all thy heart's desires. His seat is in the highest heavens, and Devotion unto him lies in communion with His Word. All-pervading, He is complete in Himself, And His light shines in every heart, His remembrance dispels all sorrows, Even the angel of death does not come near his devotee. The dead come to life by the Power of His Word, and The lowliest and the lost are received and honoured. O, Nanak! Thy prayer has been heard and accepted, and Through the Grace of the Master, His Light has been made manifest within.

If one wishes to have riddance from affliction and sorrow, One must commune with the Word, in the depths of one's soul. If one is after name and fame, One must lose his ego in the company of a saint. If one be afraid of the pangs of birth and death, One must seek shelter at the lotus feet of a saint.



From the above, written by Guru Arjan Dev, it is abundantly clear that we must go in prayer unto God or a Godman, and after being able to commune with Him, we should depend on Him alone and not on any other power; for He alone is capable of drawing one out from the mighty swirls and eddying pools of mind and matter, and of applying a healing balm to the lacerated hearts torn by wild desires and temptations. He is the strength of the weak, the sheet anchor in the storm and stress of life and a haven of safety for the homeless. His glance of Grace soothes the broken hearts.





So whether we believe it or not or we have experience of it or not.

PRAYER HAS GREAT POWER, IT MOVES REALITY. IT CHANGES REALITY.

Even scientifically the act of wanting something or asking something from the Universe, from Reality changes the movement of the tiny particles of matter.

So we can influence reality, definitely. Of course the strength and the will of doing so is also a gift from Him. Otherwise it would never even cross our mind. But if you are lucky enough to have this grace of wanting with determination to move in a certain direction and ask for the help from the Supreme Being of the Universe to come to our rescue - if you keep asking for it, it doesn't mean it happens right away, sometimes it does, most of the time you have to wait some time, sometimes months, sometimes years. It depends on the nature of our request. And it depends on when it is the best time for it to happen. This we don't know. The Supreme Intelligence knows much better. But when we ask for something definitely sooner or later it happens. In the case of my life I can say that anything I've ask ed sincerely it has happened, everything. And keeps happening. So it's for all of us, you can influence our reality by a conscious request.

Of course the request should be for spiritual purpose. But sometimes we are human beings and we can also ask for other things that are reasonable. So nothing that we do spiritually goes wasted. Sooner or later we will have an answer.

There might be certain cases in which our request doesn't meet with the Wheel of the Supreme Being, then it doesn't happen. The Wheel and plane of the Supreme Being is different and we might be amazed of it, but the Supreme Being knows all of our thoughts, all of our wishes, the tiniest, tiniest, whatever crosses our mind and knows what is good to happen and what is not good to happen.

We don't see this work all the time, but in very special moments when something very peculiar happens then we see that it was really exact to the second, that this intervention from high above is always perfect and exact.

So when we sit in meditation we request the Supreme Being to please help us to still the mind to quiet the body, to be at peace. We ask that He may manifest one of His glimpses. Maybe it won't happen in that meditation but maybe it will happen in another one.

So also in this meditation we do our best because our conscious act is very important. So we do our best to gather ourselves at the eye focus and look within, steadily, minutely, penetratingly. We keep calling on him by repeating His Holy Names and we pray that you please be kind, be good hearted, come and bless us.



About this book which you mentioned and the effect that it had on me personally about what I've written in my book. Those who have read my book they already know what was my experience with this story. If you haven't read the book then I can tell you a bit how this book had always a very profound effect on me. I mean, Master Kirpal and Sant ji always talked about constant Simran: "Develop constant Simran". Especially Sant ji was very much into it, into a constant Mantra:

"DEVELOP CONSTANT SIMRAN, YOU HAVE TO DEVELOP CONSTANT SIMRAN, THEN YOU ARE A REAL SATSANGI."

The Effect of Constant Repetition

Anyway it's difficult to get the input to start in this adventure of getting to a constant Simran because it's easy to say it, not so easy to do it, I assure you, and if anybody has tried it then he will know how difficult it is because that's really facing the mind. The mind doesn't like to be encaged and set aside while your attention is totally involved in this repetition. The mind wants to wander and if you're busy with the repetition the mind doesn't have any space to wander and so it's like a naughty boy that you put into a cage, so it begins crying and screaming and getting mad.

[Dori ji]

Sometimes you said about the mind that it is like a monkey.

[Master Sirio]

Not just a monkey, but a drunken monkey, extreme combination. Anyway, then this book came into my hands somehow, I don't remember who gave it to me. I bought it at some point but the very first time I think somebody borrowed it to me so I read the story of this pilgrim, how he began his spiritual practice when he met his master. The master first told

him: "Sit down peacefully focus your attention and repeat this prayer [mantra]." Which according to the Christian tradition, especially the Eastern church, like the Greek and the orthodox byzantine they used to repeat this very simple prayer: "Lord Jesus Christ have mercy on me" - that's all. "Keep repeating and repeating it while you relax and focus your attention, then the grace of God will come to you." He tried and in the beginning it was working. Then, after some time he began falling asleep and it didn't work anymore.

So he became disappointed and went back to his master, telling him: "Look it's not working I'm falling asleep and it's not really working, what to do?" He explained then: "I think you're not ready for this kind of practice. You should begin first by repeating it verbally. Begin like this: do 3 000 repetitions and use a rosary [mala] to follow your repetition, so you can count, because it's very important that you do 3 000." He went back to his place where he was staying and began doing the repetition of 3 000 prayers in a day. In the beginning it was very difficult, he went on up to late evening in order to make these 3 000 repetitions. He was very determined to succeed. The second day it was easier the third day he could finish before sunset. He went on like this for a couple of weeks, 3 000 per day. Eventually after a few days it became very easy and he could finish much sooner than the day would end. He was not working he had nothing to do since he was just a guardian in a garden. That's what he was doing as a job and they also gave him a hut to stay. He was a pilgrim so he kept himself busy doing his repetition and by and by he began liking it. After 10 or fifteen days he went back to his master and told him: "I've been succeeding. It has become very pleasant and very easy to do it. I finish very soon now." His master said: "So, from now on do 6 000 repetitions."



He began doing those 6 000. In the beginning it was very difficult: from 3 000 to 6 000 it is double. So the very first days he went on really up to midnight or so, in order to succeed. Then after it was a bit better, he had improved. Eventually he again became accustomed to it and could finish quite soon. With 6 000 repetitions he began to experience something more: an inner bliss, an inner intoxication and so much love radiating from his heart. Love for God. He really fell in love with God eventually, because as I say:

BETWEEN THE NAME AND THE NAMED ONE THERE IS NO DIFFERENCE AND IF YOU GO DEEP INTO THE NAME, THEN YOU GET TO THE NAMED ONE.

Eventually after two weeks again he went back to his master and told how it went: "In the beginning it was very difficult, going to 6 000 from 3 000. It was quite a work, but I managed with lots of effort. Eventually it got better and better and now it's very easy for me 6 000." His master replied: "Very good I'm very happy with you! Now go for 12 000." So from 6 000 to 12 000, double again. The first day it was terrible, his mind was really burned out, fused! You know, it's very very tough and you really have to do it constant and quick because that's the way. Some people say you don't have to do it quick otherwise it's no good; but it's not true because quantity brings up quality. Therefore, if you want to do such a busy and intense repetition, then you really have to go quick.

He began 12 000 and the first day he went on up to late in the night, then less and less and less. He would finish sooner and sooner and sooner. Eventually he got into it, 12 000. He was continuously doing it, he didn't have a moment of getting lost into the whirling of the mind, being so very busy! Obviously, he didn't do anything else, but the repetition. He wasn't really working, his job was to just stay in the garden. When you do such a repetition, at least in the beginning, you must be very busy and only doing that.

He went on like this and as a guardian, he would go out sometimes to walk around in the garden. By and by the hut in which he was living, which was a very simple place, became like a palace for him. It was so beautiful, everything began to shine and being so beautiful. *Everything became like a manifestation of God and radiated Divine Light through everything.* He developed an intense love for God, a state of great bliss and ecstasy. He felt so much uplifted! Again he returned to his master after 15 days and told him to had succeeded. "In the beginning it was terribly difficult, but then, by and by it became better and better. Now I do it very easily and I enjoy it very much. This is what I am experiencing now..." - and he told his master about all his experiences.

What he was experiencing sounds like not just a higher state of consciousness, but like a complete shift in his consciousness. Was it?

[Master Sirio]

Yes, a complete shift, not just upliftment, but a huge upliftment. His master concluded: "Now I think it's very much implanted in you to do this repetition, so, you don't need to count anymore. From now on just go on repeating your prayer without counting it."

So he went on like this. Eventually left the place because autumn came and his job was only for the summer. They didn't need him any more, because in winter you can't have a garden in Russia. He left and began wandering by going to various places of pilgrimage. In Russia there are several places of pilgrimage which are very venerated, honored by the devotees so he kept going from one place to the other.

In all these wanderings he kept doing his repetition, his continuous prayer and he had such wonderful experiences, such wonderful encounters. When you are in that state of grace then everything becomes magic. All the meetings that you have with any person, in any situation is like a divine event. That's how it is in reality!



The Way of the Pilgrim is the first-hand account of an anonymous Pilgrim traveling across nineteenth-century Russia in a quest to learn to "pray without ceasing." Finally, the Pilgrim encountered a holy monk who introduced him to the ancient Byzantine tradition of 'hesychia' (stillness or rest in God).

I know that you also had your own experiences with the constant repetition when you dedicated periods in your life to do constant repetition. But still it's a very crucial point on the path of Surat Shabd Yoga that one has to earn the honest living and we also often say that the greatness of this Path is that one doesn't have to become a monk or a pilgrim and we can stay in the world and have family and have a job.

It's very important also for the spiritual growth, to be capable to live our life and apply this kind of higher level of consciousness in the everyday life. How can the two things be connected?

[Master Sirio]

If you want to try this, it's very important to take a few free days. For example take a weekend and instead of going fooling around, you know what to do if you are a true seeker of God? You get up early in the morning on Saturday and Sunday and get busy with your spiritual practice. That's how it goes. So you can do your work five days and the other two days dedicate to more spiritual practice. I'm not advising or advocating that you get to this kind of repetition like the pilgrim, but in those two days or when you have some holidays if you want to really get into *what is the juice of a spiritual Path*, that's what you have to do. Instead of going for vacation at the beach, you stay in your home or go to the mountains, etc. and *do intense practice*. In my case, when I read that book, I thought, *"Well, if he did it, why shouldn't I be able to do it?"*

Of course, I was doing Simran after I took Initiation from Master and I was doing lots of meditation. It was in those very two first years when I was doing my meditation all the time. When I stopped meditating I did the Simran, but not so really focused on it. When I read this book, I felt that I had to try this!

I began doing this 3 000 repetitions by counting them and I went on for three days. Beside this, I was doing lots of meditation also. At some point, I began having really incredible experiences, like flying out of the body like anything and perceiving an incredibly intense spiritual power. I thought, "My God this is going to be too much for me."

Yes. My mind really felt like being fused, like melting down...

I absolutely love the Ashram. I was just looking at photos today and was overcome with a profound peace and strong silence. I miss being there.



Report 2024. Spring Retreat

Once again we have had a very uplifting and wonderful Retreat. Infinite gratitude for I having been there. *Grazie mille di cuore!*

I have written many times about my experiences of Guru, Naam, Satsang, Darshan, how much I cherish them. I have written about them many times. 


Dearest my Sweetheart Baba Ji my Sun, my Eternal my Love forever!


